How many discounts can I get with the Rx discount card?

There is no limit to how often you can use your Rx discount card, and you can use it on **FDA-approved** brand name *and* **generic** prescription medications.

Is this insurance? Why would I use this if I already have insurance?

No, it's not insurance. It's a **prescription discount card**. With the Rx discount card, you might get a **better price** on prescriptions than what your insurance offers.

How do I use the Rx discount card?

To compare your options and see which price is better, **ask your pharmacist:** "Can you please check to see if the OptumRx price would be **lower** than my health insurance plan's price?"

Can I use both insurance and the Rx discount card at the same time? Is insurance required?

No, insurance is NOT required. If you do have insurance, when you buy your prescriptions, use **either** your insurance **OR** the Rx discount card.

Do I need to be an AARP member?

AARP members get deeper discounts and additional benefits, but **membership is not required**. Request a member Rx discount card if you belong to AARP, or a **nonmember version** if you do not.
