How many **discounts** can I get with the Rx discount card?

Is this insurance? Why would I use this if I already have insurance?

There is no limit to how often you can use your Rx discount card, and you can use it on FDA-approved brand name and generic prescription medications.

No, it's not insurance. It's a prescription discount card. With the Rx discount card, you might get a better **price** on prescriptions than what your insurance offers.

How do I use the Rx discount card?

To compare your options and see which price is better, ask your pharmacist: "Can you please check to see if the OptumRx price would be lower than my health insurance plan's price?"

Can I use both **insurance** and the **Rx discount card** at the same time? *Is insurance* required?

No, insurance is NOT required.

If you do have insurance, when you buy your prescriptions, use either your insurance **OR** the Rx discount card.

Do I need to be an AARP member?

AARP members get deeper discounts and additional benefits, but membership is **not required.** Request a member Rx discount card if you belong to AARP, or a **nonmember** version if you do not.
